Terms & Conditions

- Non-degree seeking students are responsible for meeting any requirements for the class (pre-requisites, co-requisites, etc).
- Non-degree seeking students are not eligible for on-campus housing, nor does the University of Miami recommend relocating to Miami as part of this online course experience.
- Online non-degree seeking students do not have access to on-campus resources, facilities, athletic events, parking passes, or support services.
- Online non-degree seeking students are not issued a Cane Card and will not be able to access any buildings on campus.
- As an admitted Spring 2026 student, your status as a degree-seeking student at the University of Miami will begin in January at the Spring 2026 Cane Kickoff orientation.
- Online courses, including the courses in this program, do not count toward the minimum credit requirement to be eligible to join Greek life.
- Classes taken through DCIE will automatically be added to your official University of Miami transcript and may be used toward your degree completion.
- Students in this program are bound by all policies outlined in the Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook available at miami.edu/srr.
- Failure to attend all classes may impact grades and final grades will be included in your official University of Miami transcript.
- Non-degree students participating in this course experience agree to not take classes at any other institution during the fall 2025 semester. Credits earned at another institution while enrolled in this program will not be considered or accepted.
- Non-degree students wishing to drop any or all courses they are enrolled in must follow the [University Withdrawal Process](#).
- Failure to pay for courses may result in cancellation of class schedule and a hold placed on current and subsequent semesters.
- All non-degree courses are charged at the University [per credit tuition rate](#). Financial aid will not be applied for any courses taken through this program.
- The University reserves the right to withdraw an offer of admission if a student engages or has engaged in behavior that violates the standards of conduct to which all University of Miami students are held.
- Students cannot earn credit for a course that they have previously taken and passed with a grade of C or higher or received CR credit.
